Peter Q. Cagle, Jr., The Mayor of the Town of Talking Rock, GA., 67, died Sunday, October 14 2013. Born on June 17, 1946, he lived most of his youth in Sandy Springs. Raised in a family with a strong love of country, Peter joined the Navy out of Sandy Springs High School where he was first stationed on the USS Ranger and later transferred to river patrol in Vietnam on Patrol Boat until 1969. His country, community and family were important. After receiving an honorable discharge and returning home, he became a motorcycle police officer for the City of Atlanta Police Department where he was proud to serve for over 28 years.

Peter retired to ride his Harley in 1998, to enjoy life with his family, then moved to the Town of Talking Rock, GA., and ran a family shop for many years. It did not take long before he was asked to serve again when he was elected Mayor of his small town. He took great pride in the care and improvement of his community. The need to serve still strong and feeling like his job was not complete for the community, he looked forward to continuing as Mayor in the upcoming November election,
