



## Mr. Phillip J. "Phil" Sullivan

June 24, 1928 - April 5, 2015

Born in Bessemer, AL. Attended GA Tech under the US Navy's V-5 program. Entered Navy flight training earning his wings in 1949. Married his sweetheart Jennie while on duty in Bermuda. After completing 8 years of active duty he returned to GA Tech where he was a member of Pi Kappa Alpha, Tau Beta Pi honor society and Pi Tau Sigma Engineering honor society. He graduated with a BS in Aeronautical Engineering and an MS in Mechanical Engineering and while teaching mathematics. Joined Lockheed Aircraft in 1957 as an engineer in Fluid Dynamics. Later served as Deputy Chief Engineer for the L-1011 Tristar commercial airliner. He was President of Lockheed Aircraft Corp. Canada from 1976-1983. Transferred from Canada and assigned in Washington DC as Senior Vice President Of Government Requirements of Lockheed Martin Corporation. Retired from Lockheed in 1988. He had continued his Navy flying as a reservist, retiring from the Navy in 1976 as a Captain.

Throughout his life he sang tenor in his church choirs as well as several choral societies and clubs. His church and his family were very important to him his whole life. He was an Elder in the Presbyterian Church. He was also very active in the Navy League, Rotary Club and several community and civic organizations. Survived by his wife of 65 years Jeanette, daughter Cindy Kaldor (Bruce), sons Tim (Cindy), Ramsay (Lisa), grandchildren Claire, Emily and Amy Sullivan, Amy Bremner (Luke), Bruce Kaldor, four great grandchildren, and sister Nancy Ahrens (Bill).
