CAGLE – Raymond Clarence Cagle, 68 of Marietta, passed away on October 29, 2008. He was born on October 26, 1940 in the Cobb County community known as Mt. Bethel to the late Clarence Greely Cagle and Duvell (Mackey) Cagle. Raymond attended east Side Elementary School and Sprayberry High School. He was formerly with the Fuller's Fire Department in the 1960's in Cobb County. In 1960, he married his high school sweetheart, Stacia Juanita Potts. They had two children, the late Raymond Him and Stacia Jennifer. His daughter married Robert Mentus, II in 2003 and they gave Raymond a grandson, Robert John Mentus, III in 2006. He had a love of gardening and raised tomatoes at his East Cobb home and sold those tomatoes to all who stopped in. Anyone who bought Raymond's produce knew it was 100% organic and the best quality around! Raymond was an honorary member of the Kennesaw Jaycees and the North Fulton Jaycees. He helped to raise money for his community at the North Georgia State Fair in the 1990's with the Kennesaw Jaycees and by participating in fund raising efforts with the North Fulton Jaycees. Raymond will be missed by all as he touched so many lives in the great state of Georgia. The funeral service is on Friday, October 31, 2008 at 12:00 PM in the chapel of Northside Chapel Funeral Directors, with Raymond's cousins, Elders Edward and Randall Cagle officiating.
