April 11, 1929 - April 27, 2009

CHATHAM – Rev. Marvin F. Chatham, age 80 of Roswell, died April 27, 2009. Born in Fulton County, Rev. Chatham was ordained to the ministry on October 19, 1963 at Mt. Oliver Baptist Church and served as pastor at nine Baptist churches over 30 years in the Jasper and Pleasant Valley Associations. He was a residential home builder for many years. He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Floy Nix Chatham of Roswell; sons, Mark and Vickie Chatham of St. Louis, MO, Myron and Barbara Chatham of Woodsotck and Michael and Linda Chatham of Woodstock; sister, Joyce and J. D. Stephens of Roswell; brother, Howard and Grace Chatham of Roswell; grandchildren, Kimberly Chatham, Kevin Chatham, Ryan Chatham and Carrie Chatham; great-grandchildren, Austin, Payton and Harley.
