HARDEMAN – Rev. Roy Jackson (Jack) Hardeman, age 92 of Atlanta went to be with his Lord on Wednesday, November 9, 2011. Rev. Hardeman was born in Atlanta and served as a Bi-Vocational Baptist Pastor for over 50 years, serving several churches in the North Fulton area. He was a U. S.
