Ricky Lee Gauthier, age 65 of Alpharetta, GA died April 12, 2013. Rick was born in 1947 to Rudolph and Edith Kendall Gauthier in Louisville, KY, and attended Clarksville, Indiana public schools after the family relocated. He earned his bachelors and masters degrees from Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana, where he met and married the love of his life, Clara Fabian Gauthier. A veteran of the U.S. Navy, Rick supervised and directed on-board electronic countermeasure during the Vietnam War on the U.S.S. Independence and around the globe.
