



## Mr. Robert (Bob) Emmett O'Hagan

February 10, 1938 - October 22, 2022

Robert (Bob) Emmett O'Hagan, 84, of Alpharetta, GA passed away on Saturday October 22nd, at home.

Bob grew up in Scarsdale NY and attended Eastchester High School. After graduating from the College of the Holy Cross (Worcester, MA) in 1960 with a BS in Marketing, he married Rochelle (Menestrena). Bob and family moved around the East Coast during his early years with Ford Motor Company, and then settled in Midland Park, NJ. In Midland Park for almost 30 years, Bob and Rochelle had many close neighbors and friends; Bob participated fully in religious (lector and lay leadership in the Church of the Nativity Catholic Parish) and recreational (tennis, golf and family camping) activities while working in car and heavy truck operations for Ford Motor Company. In the early 90's, Bob was transferred to Alpharetta, GA, where he retired and enjoyed many new friendships (especially the guys in WARM), local tennis and golf, and serving as lector at St Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church. Bob was preceded in death by his parents, James and Gladys (Bach) O'Hagan and his brother, John P O'Hagan. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Rochelle, by his sister Elizabeth Ann (O'Hagan) Murphy of Miami FL, by daughters Kathleen (Kyle Ramsey), Christine (Daniel) Thompson, Karen F O'Hagan and Patricia (Christian) LaPorte, grandchildren Michael (Sally Bull) Thompson, Kelsey (Mackenzie) Therrien, Matthew Ramsey and Zachary and Abigail LaPorte, and 4 great-grandchildren (Samuel, Gabriel, Mason and Addison Therrien).

A funeral mass will be held at St Thomas Aquinas Church, Alpharetta GA on Saturday, October 29 at 10AM. Inurnment is private.
