



Robert Lee (Bob) Kirby

June 21, 1948 - August 4, 2009

Mr. Robert L. (Bob) Kirby, 61, of Alpharetta, died August 4, 2009. Born in Atlanta to Ralph and Mildred Moore Kirby, Bob was a long time resident of Alpharetta and a 1966 graduate of Milton High School. He attended West Georgia College, graduated from Georgia State University in 1975 and from the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University in 1988. Bob was a former president of the North Fulton Bar Association, a United States Air Force veteran, serving in the Philippines and two tours in Korea. Bob was a volunteer pilot for Angel Flight, which transports patients for medical treatment for free. He was Assistant Chief of the Sparta Volunteer Fire Dept., member of the Alpharetta Rotary Club and Trinity Presbyterian Church. Along with his parents he was preceded in death by his son, Peter Tillman Kirby. He is survived by his wife, Auneca Winters Kirby; son, Matt Kirby; grandson, Austin Kirby all of Alpharetta; sister, Janet Kirby Campbell and her husband Charles of Thomasville; father-in-law, Jim Winters and several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held on Friday, August 7 at 2 p.m. in the funeral home chapel. Rev.
