



Mr. Robert Sequerth

March 4, 1931 - December 30, 2021

Former Dunwoody resident Robert Sequerth died Dec. 30, 2021, after a short illness, at 90.

Born in LeRoy, NY, on March 4, 1931, Bob excelled in football, basketball and track, and he was a member of the marching band at LeRoy High School. After graduating in 1950, Bob began his 48-year career at Lapp Insulator Co. In 1954, he married the former Ann Gleason and they had seven children. In addition to job and family responsibilities, he was a volunteer fireman for more than 25 years, and was elected to both the village Board of Trustees and the Town Council in his hometown. He was a past recipient of the LeRoyan of the Year award.

In 1977, Lapp promoted him to Southeast Region sales manager, and he moved his family to Dunwoody. After retiring in 1998, he and Ann moved to Lake Hartwell, where he continued to enjoy golf with his friends and time on the lake with his extended family.

Bob was predeceased by his wife of nearly 66 years in 2020 and by their youngest son, Michael. He is survived by six children: John of Roswell, GA; Mark of Pflugerville, Texas; Catherine (Harvey) Meyer of Dunwoody, GA; Richard (Kathryn) of Mount Pleasant, SC; Martha (Ronald) Olsen of Johns Creek, GA; and David (Nora) of Savannah, GA. He is also survived by 11 grandchildren, who gave him great pleasure

He will be buried at Arlington Memorial Park in Sandy Springs. A memorial Mass will be held at a future date at Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church in

Hartwell, GA, his home parish.
