November 5, 1944 - September 19, 2008

Lehrfeld – Mr. Robert William Lehrfeld, Jr., age 63 of Alpharetta, GA died Friday, September 19, 2008 at the VA Medical Center in Atlanta. He was the oldest of three siblings, born in Kingston, NY on November 5, 1944. Mr. Lehrfeld attended St. Patrick's Elementary School and was a 1963 graduate of Bayshore High School, where he was a member of the swim team for 4 years. After graduation, Rob entered the U.S. Army, where he underwent basic training at Ft. Dix, NJ, and was later assigned to Okinawa, Japan with the NIKE air defense battery. In 1965, he re-enlisted for communications training at Ft. Mammouth, NJ. Mr. Lehrfeld then received orders for Vietnam in April of 1966, where he was assigned to MAC-headquarters under 69th Signal Battalion, 593rd Signal Company, under General Westmoreland, as Chief Communications Specialist. After serving his country in Vietnam, Mr. Lehrfeld was rotated back to the U.S. to Ft. Wainwright, AK for the next two years, and was honorably discharged on July 2, 1969 from Ft. Lewis, WA. He is survived by his wife, Judy; step-daughter, Cricket Russell of Atlanta; three step-sons, James Dixon of Pennsylvania, Thomas Bennett of Atlanta, and Anthony Bennett of Wilmington, NC; mother, Rita Zurmuhlen Lehrfeld; sister, Kathi Malchesky of East Islip, KY; and brother, Richard Lehrfeld of Syracuse, NY. A memorial service will be held on Monday, September 22 at 1:00 PM from Northside Chapel Funeral Directors in Roswell, GA, 770/645-1414, www.northsidechapel.com.
