Roger Boyd Rodden, 73, passed peacefully at his home in Roswell, GA, on November 29, 2023. surrounded by family and loved ones.

Roger led a full and rich life as an entrepreneur, history buff and avid golfer. Born on November 18, 1950, to Eulala (Boyd) and army serviceman Thomas Rodden, Roger grew up with his 4 siblings in Taylorville, IL. His favorite childhood memories were playing in the 1963 Illinois State Championships as a Little League shortstop and summer adventures with cousins in the Ozarks. Roger earned a BS in Business from Eastern Illinois University and was a member of the Sigma Pi fraternity. In 1973, he married the love of his life, Nadine (Ludwig) of Hillsboro, IL. During their 50 years together, Roger and Nadine raised two daughters, created beautiful homes, and provided much encouragement and support to one another in their respective entrepreneurial successes. In 1977, Roger and family moved to Cresco, IA, where he served the farming community by managing the Rodden-Johnson John Deere Implement and met some of his dearest lifelong friends. In 1988, they relocated to Roswell, GA, where he started a new business as a vehicle wholesaler, financier, and mentor to others in the industry—a career that he enjoyed for over 35 years.
