August 30, 1929 - August 19, 2021

Ronald L. Hudgins, age 91 of Roswell, GA passed away at his home August 19, 2021 with his daughters at his side. A native Atlantan, he held an Associate Degree in Industrial Management from Georgia Tech and completed courses in real estate, sales and management. He served eight years with the 179th Field Artillery 48th Division Georgia National Guard. Ronald retired from Atlanta Gas Light Company after forty-one years of employment. He was a past president and director of the Northside Optimist Club and was named Optimist of the Year 1965-1966. Ronald joined the Roundtable in 1964 to pursue his interest in Atlanta history and Civil War history where he grew an interest in Margaret Mitchell and Gone With The Wind. He collected both Civil War artifacts and GWTW memorabilia and was associated with several GWTW museums. Ronald also enjoyed retirement with his family and golf. He was an active member at Roswell First Baptist Church.

Ronald was preceded in death by his wife of fifty years, Joyce Stancil Hudgins. He is survived by his daughters, Sherry Coleman and Pam Hudgins, four grandchildren, Josh Gralton, Joe Gralton, Joy McClanahan, Gabe Bowen and other extended family.
