



Ms. Ruth Barratt

Ruth Shoptaugh Barratt, 89, passed away peacefully of natural causes on November 18, 2015. She was surrounded by her loving family where she lived in Roswell, GA.

Ruth was born in Jersey City, NJ but was raised in northern KY and Erie, PA. She was married to the late William E. Barratt MD for 48 years. They raised their four children in Painesville, OH. Ruth was an active member of Mentor Christian Church where she taught Junior High Sunday school classes. She was also a member of the Western Reserve Junior Service League. She founded the "Meals on Wheels" program serving Lake County, Ohio which began as a volunteer program and grew into a funded, county program which she directed. Other volunteer activities included Lake County Memorial Hospital, and reading in public schools.

Upon her husband's retirement, they moved to Murphy, NC for 6 months and Vero Beach, FL for 6 months out of the year. She was an active member of the Murphy Presbyterian Church where she volunteered in their food distribution program. In Vero Beach, she was an active member of the First Presbyterian Church where served as an Elder, Deacon and Sunday school teacher.

Ruth joined two of her children and their families the last two years of her life in Roswell, Georgia. She spent many happy moments enjoying their company. She is survived by her children William E. Barratt, John E. Barratt, Peter J. Barratt (Anne), and Amy B. Morgan (Steve), along with the three lights of her
