Samuel D. Johnson, Jr. age 86, of Atlanta, GA. passed away on June 14, 2007. After graduating from Chamblee Hugh School in 1939, Mr. Johnson enlisted in the US Army Air Corps at the beginning of WW II to proudly serve his beloved country. He was assigned duty overseas in Framingham, England as a top turret gunner on a B17 bomber, 390th bombardment group. He flew 28 missions over Germany. Mr. Johnson was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, Silver Star and 3 Oak Leaf Clusters for bravery. After the war, Mr. Johnson was employed by Sears Robuck & Company as a paint and hardware manager. After 10 years with Sears, he joined his father in the house building business. He also became a real estate broker until retirement. After retirement, he remained active and started his own paint and home repair business, Johnson Enterprises. Mr. Johnson was preceded in death by his adoring wife of 62 years, Sarah Belle of Mount Union, PA. Mr. Johnson is survived by his 4 children, Anne Barrow of Wylie, TX, Steve Johnson of Roswell, Paul Johnson of Lilburn, and Brian Johnson of Sugar Hill; 2 sisters, Mary Wooten of Cumming and Evelyn Camp of North Carolina. He also leaves behind 4 grandchildren, Derek Johnson of Holly Springs, Katie Johnson of Flowery Branch, Stacy Murray of Richardson, TX and Brandy Barrow of Addison, TX, and one great grandchild, Brooke Belle Murray of Richardson, TX.
