Beloved wife, mother, and friend Sharon Stringer Consoli lost her valiant battle with cancer on Monday May 25, 2009. Sharon was born in Greensboro, NC on April 20, 1964 to parents Scott and Carolyn Stringer. 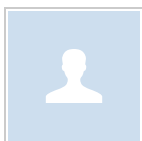

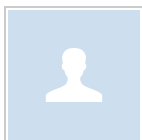
