November 18, 1917 - March 6, 2008

MASCOTTI – Silvio L. “Scotty” Mascotti age 90, of St. George Village in Roswell GA, and formerly of Bessemer Michigan, died March 6, 2008. Mr. Mascotti served in the U.S. Army in the Middle East Service in Egypt. He was a 1948 Graduate of the Atlanta Law School. He was a retired Labor Attorney for the National Labor Relations Board, and then worked for several years at the Adair – Goldthwaite Labor Law Firm. In 1997 Mr. Mascotti was recognized for serving fifty years by the Atlanta Bar Association. He was a member of St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church in Roswell, and previously a member of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Atlanta. He and his wife for many years spent the winter months here in Georgia and the summer months in their home in Michigan. He is survived by his wife Mrs. Margaret Sedlock Mascotti; nephews James Quade and his wife Mary of Bradenton FL, Robert Quade and his wife Aida of Lakewood CO, William Quade and his wife Joan of Midland MI; niece Gloria Fenton and her husband John of Bethesda MD; many loving friends and acquaintances. Funeral Mass will be on Monday at St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church at 1 PM with Father Frank McNamee to officiate. Interment will be in Bessemer MI. The family will receive friends on Sunday from 3-5 PM at the funeral home with a Rosary Service to begin at 5 PM.
