Sophie Anna Klippel, age 23, of Roswell, Georgia, was tragically taken from her family in an automobile accident on March 12, 2026.

Sophie was a bright, compassionate, and deeply thoughtful young woman whose presence brought warmth and light to everyone around her. She had a curious mind and a generous spirit, and she carried herself with both intelligence and heart. She was drawn to understanding people and how to care for them, which led her to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Neuroscience at DePaul University.

Sophie earned her CNA license and worked nights at St Joseph's Hospital as a Patient Care Technician while continuing her studies at Mercer University to become a Nurse Practitioner, a reflection of her strength, discipline, and deep commitment to helping others. Sophie was building a life centered on care, purpose, and making a difference.

Sophie attended Roswell North Elementary, Crabapple Middle, and Roswell High School, where she formed lifelong friendships and left a lasting impression on classmates and teachers alike. Sophie had a quiet strength, she listened deeply, cared fully, and loved those around her with sincerity and kindness. She had a way of making people feel seen, understood, and valued. She loved deeply, laughed easily, and found joy in the simple moments shared

with the people she cared about most.

More than anything, Sophie was a beloved daughter, sister, and granddaughter. She shared a deep and special bond with her mother, Kelly; her father, David; and her sister, Lena. Her family was the center of her world, and she will always remain at the center of theirs.

Sophie is survived by her mother, Kelly Klippel; her father, David Klippel; her sister, Lena Klippel; her grandmother, June Klippel; and a loving extended family of aunts, uncles, cousins, and dear friends who will continue to carry her memory forward.

A memorial service to celebrate Sophie's life will be held on April 18, 2026, at 2:00 PM at Northside Chapel, 12050 Crabapple Road, Roswell, Georgia. The family will receive friends and loved ones at Northside Chapel 30 minutes to the service.

“ I didn't know Sophie the way those closest to her did. I met her twice; once on a bright weekend in California, once at a celebration in Mendocino, but even in those small windows of time, what she was came through completely. She was fully and unabashedly herself. A heart with arms and legs. Someone whose presence made a room more alive, whose humor landed without cruelty, whose joy was not performed but simply was.



Some people carry a particular kind of energy that the world genuinely needs. Sophie was one of those people. She was just beginning, whole decades of healing and laughing and loving still to be given. And yet even in her short time here, she gave so much. I don't know with certainty what happens when our consciousness leaves our flesh and blood and bones. I hold that mystery with open hands. But there is a tradition that understands all things as interconnected, that nothing is ever truly lost, only transformed, continuing forward in ways we can't always see or name. And I believe that someone who loved as fully as Sophie did leaves something real behind. Not just memory. Presence. The kind that lingers in the people she touched and moves forward through them into the world.

The word important comes from the Latin importare, to carry within. And so this is how I will honor her: by carrying her within me. Her laugh. Her fullness. The particular way she made everything feel warmer and more alive. I will carry her into rooms she never entered, into years she won't see, into a life made richer for having briefly touched hers.

To her mother and her sister, who loved her most and are carrying the heaviest weight right now: Sophie was seen. She was felt. The joy she brought into this world was real and it mattered and it does not disappear. It lives in everyone she ever made laugh, ever made feel welcome, ever made feel like themselves.

May whatever comes after this life hold her gently and joyfully, surrounded by peace and love, because those were the things she gave so freely. She deserves to receive them back, endlessly,

wherever she is now.
