



Mr. Thomas Charles Adams

June 11, 1947 - January 19, 2016

Thomas C. Adams, age 68, died unexpectedly in his Roswell home on the morning of January 19, 2016. The cause of death was due to heart failure. Thom was born June 11, 1947 in Missoula, Montana. He was raised in Montana and resided in several cities during his lifetime including Omaha, Nebraska; Missoula, Montana; Dallas, Texas; and the remaining 21 years in Roswell, GA. Thom's early adult life was spent in the military where he honorably served in the US Air Force and was deployed overseas during the Vietnam War. After serving his country, Thom attended college at the University of Montana and received a bachelor's degree in business administration. This degree led to several management positions in the banking and retail sector. Thom was retired at the time of his death. Survivors include his beloved wife of 43 years (Donetta Adams); sister in Alpharetta (Margaret Adams); brother in Missoula, MT (James Adams); brother in Humansville, MO (Frank Adams); and brother in Canton, GA (Grant Adams). Thom was preceded in death by his father (Frank Adams) and mother (Margaret Adams). A memorial service for the immediate family will take place on 1/29/16 at the Georgia National Cemetery in Canton, GA where his ashes will be interred.
