April 15, 1947 - November 30, 2022

Thomas “Tom” Francis Farrell, age 75, of Woodstock, Georgia passed away at home after a lengthy battle with Parkinson’s Disease on Wednesday, November 30th, 2022. Tom was born April 15th, 1947 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the son of John and Jean Farrell (Higgins).

After earning a degree from the University of Pittsburgh, Tom started his career of 32 years for NFS/Getty/Texaco/Shell. He enjoyed mentoring others and made many lifelong friendships through his stops in Olney, Maryland; Tulsa, Oklahoma; Duluth, Georgia and The Woodlands, Texas.

While Tom was a huge Pittsburgh Steelers and Pittsburgh Pirates fan, what he loved most was spending time with his family.
