



Mr. Thomas Augustus Mote

April 5, 1930 - June 12, 2019

Thomas (Tom) Augustus Mote, 89, of Alpharetta, went to his heavenly home June 12, 2019. He was preceded in death by his wife, Gloria S. Mote (d. 1983) and his son Mark T. Mote (d. 2019). Having remarried, he is survived by his wife, Caroline Hosking Mote; daughter, Valerie Mote; step daughters, Mary Foster (Keith), Laura Daniel (Gene) and Lynn Hosking Diffin (Peter). He is also survived by 10 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.

He grew up in Atlanta and is a graduate of O'Keefe High School and attended the Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia (Georgia State University). He was in the US Navy Reserve '47 – '53 at NAS-Atlanta when he was called to Active Duty '54 – '59 and assigned to Squadron UP671 flying the PBY and P2V Aircrafts. After being Honorably Discharged from the Navy he worked for the Henry S. Clark Co. Upon the death of Henry Clark, Tom inherited the company which eventually became Mote-Osborne and Associates (automotive parts manufacturer rep). He retired in 1996. Over the years he was a member of the Jaycees, Lions Club, and Rotary International. He enjoyed his various roles in the Roswell Rotary Club from serving on the Board of Directors to being named Rotarian of the Year 1997, staffing their various fundraisers and in recent years setting up for the weekly meetings and greeting members as they arrived. He very much enjoyed serving the community with this organization. One of the highlights of his membership in Rotary was serving in their partnership with Honor Flight, an organization which transports senior veterans of our Armed Forces to Washington DC to

visit their memorials. Over the years he enjoyed boating & fishing, roses, insisted on changing his own break pads, Brave Baseball, the Georgia Bulldogs and wood working; making furniture and birdhouses which many friends and family enjoy.
