April 5, 1957 - February 28, 2011

Todd Milne, age 53 of Woodstock went home to be with the Lord on February 28, 2011 after a long courageous battle with cancer. Pre-deceased by his father, James Milne, and survived by loving wife of 31 years, Gina Milne, and three children of whom he was extremely proud, Stephanie, Scott and Spencer. Todd earned a Bachelor's degree in Biology from West Chester State University in 1979 and went on to earn a Master of Science in Water Resource Engineering from Villanova University in 1986. Todd earned many awards for his hard work and determination. In 2009, while undergoing cancer treatment, he earned the Professional Manager of Project Certification. With over 25 years experience in environmental remediation, he served as CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. Southeast Regional Construction Manager. Todd was born in Minnesota and grew up outside of Philadelphia, PA. After several moves during his adult years, he moved to Atlanta 6 years ago when he joined CH2M Hill. He was a man of great character and altruism. Most of all, he was an amazing father and outstanding husband, and will be forever deeply missed. The family would like to thank all of their friends for their support. We would especially like to thank Todd's co-workers and CH2M Hill for their continuous kindness and support, a rarity in today's professional world. We would also like to thank Trish and Paul Adack and Gloria and Al Saggese, Todd's in-laws, for their unwavering support over the last 31 years and especially over the last 4 ½ years. 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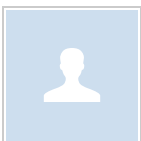
