Vigelo Servera MD grew up in Sarnia, Ontario, Canada. He graduated from the University of Toronto in 1988. Dr. Servera received his medical degree from the University of the East, Philippines in 1993. He finished his Internal Medicine residency at the Medical College of Ohio in Toledo in 1999. Dr. Servera practiced as a General Internal Medicine physician since 2000 in Cumming, Georgia before joining Main Street Internal Medicine and Pediatrics, PC. Dr. Servera retired on October 2020 and passed away on April 07, 2022.

He is survived by his wife Maribel, son VJ, parents and siblings.

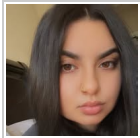
