



Walter Alvin Eaves

January 5, 1926 - August 13, 2022

Walter A. Eaves, age 96, passed away Saturday, August 13, 2022 at his home in Roswell. He was preceded in death by his parents Donald and Robena Eaves, and his wife Harriet Powell Eaves.

Walter was born on January 5, 1926 in West Palm Beach, Florida. The family had moved to Florida briefly and moved back to Georgia shortly after he was born. He graduated from Tech High School in 1943. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in January 1944, and was honorably discharged in May 1946. Even though his time of service was short, he was very proud to have served his country.

In February 1947 he began working at East Point Commercial Bank. In January 1950 he was sworn in as Assistant Bank Examiner for State Banking Department of Georgia. In September 1952 he joined The National Exchange Bank of Augusta and worked there until April 1, 1954 when he began working at Roswell Bank as Executive Vice President. He became President in March 1958 and retired as Chairman of the Board, President and CEO in 1981. After retiring from the bank he operated a construction company and did some consulting work. In 1996, he "retired for good"!

Walter was a member of Roswell United Methodist Church serving on the Administrative Board, Finance Committee, Usher and member of the

Trustees. He was a member and past president of Roswell Rotary Club, the American Legion, VFW and North Fulton Businessmen's Association. He spent 10 years with Roswell Youth Baseball Association, serving as President, a manager and coach.

Walter married Sarah Harriet Powell on February 4, 1950. They were married 53 years. One of their favorite things to do was play golf. He played with the men, she played with the women and they played together. He was fortunate enough to continue playing until he was 90 years old.

He enjoyed spending time with his family and always made family vacations a priority, spending time in Gatlinburg, Hilton Head and most recently Seagrove Beach.

Walter is survived by his 2 children: son Harold (Hal) Walter Eaves, daughter Janet E. Neese, son-in-law Randy and grandson Joshua, his wife Barbara and great-grandson Dylan. Also his sister Peggy Culver of Ft. Worth, Texas, his nephew Ricky Culver (Suzie) of Conyers, his nieces Pam Callahan (Don) and family of Knoxville and Susie Beasley (Mike) of Canton and Laura Powell.
