



Weldon Waldrop

November 23, 1926 - July 20, 2007

Mr. Weldon Edward Waldrop, age 80, of Alpharetta, passed away, July 20, 2007. He was born on November 23, 1926 in Shawnee, Oklahoma. He was the descendent of William Clark Waldrop and Margaret Elizabeth Chatham. He proudly served his country for eight years and seven months in the Army, Army Reserve, and Air Force. He was drafted in the US Army as Pvt. Weldon E. Waldrop on February 22, 1945. During his service he served in the Phillipine Islands, during WW II. His service in the Air Force was in Germany during the Berlin Blockade and service in Japan during the Korean Conflict. He was honored with 14 metals for loyal service. He was honorably discharged from the Army on November 14, 1946. He was honorably discharged from the US Air Force on September 14, 1953. On October 7, 1955 he was married to Geraldine Ann Hunter. She was the daughter of Vernon and Ida Hunter. They had six children during their marriage. He lived and raised his family in Alpharetta. He retired with 37 years of service at Lockheed. He was a member of the American Legion Post 201 in Alpharetta. He was a member of the VFW Post 7583 of Roswell. He was actively involved in the progression of the community. He served on the board of the Alpharetta Historical Society. He is survived by his children, Leah and Eben Cartwright of Waleska, Ricky and Nancy Waldrop of Marietta, Lisa and Andy Cartwright of Gainesville, Lonnie and Susie Waldrop of Cumming, Melinda Brown of Canton, and Billy and Stephanie Waldrop of Acworth; sisters, Pat Walker and Eula Mae Maxwell both of Alpharetta; 14 grandchildren; 11 great-

grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, July 24, 2007 at 1:00 PM in the funeral home chapel. Rev. Tom Burdett officiating.
