November 6, 1925 - January 1, 2008

Mr. William S. "Bill" Barrett, 82 of Commerce formerly of Alpharetta died January 1, 2008. A Banks County native, Bill was the youngest of 12 children of John B. and Naomi Jones Barrett. He attended Banks County High School and Rutgers University. He joined the United States Army at the age of 17, serving with the 3rd Army in the European Theatre of operations in World War II. After the Battle of the Bulge, he was transferred to the Pacific Theatre of operations, winning the bronze and silver star. Mr. Barrett is the former President of the Citizens Bank of Alpharetta. He was a Mason and a member of the Lions Club. He was also the co-founder and President of the North Fulton Chamber of Commerce, Past member of the Board of Directors of the Clayton County Bank, Gwinnett County Bank and Cobb County Bank. Mr. Barrett served on the board of directors of the Georgia March of Dimes, the American Cancer Society, the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and was an advisor to the Fulton County Board of Education. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Betty Parks Barrett and son Timothy Barrett. He is survived by his wife, Maxine Barrett; daughter, Beth Moss; sons and daughters-in-law, David and Pat Barrett, Doug and Eleanor Barrett, Jeannie Barrett, Scott Banks, Clay and Nicollett Banks ;sister, Polly Twork and her husband, Ray; Grandchildren, David Barrett II, Michael and Stephanie Barrett, Paul Moss, Lindsey Moss, Stephen and Kelly Barrett, Brian and Christiana Barrett, Billie Barrett and Robert Henry; 6 great grandchildren.
