William Littleton Brown, 89, of Roswell passed into Glory on Thursday, June 28, 2018.

He is predeceased by his parents, James and Lillie Brown; sisters, Vivian Brown, Geneva Henderson, Ruth Crowder, Inez Bright, Cynthia Brown, Virginia Brown; brother, James L. Brown; and son, Jeffrey Brown.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Rebecca Ruth Brown; son, William Dean (Lillian) Brown of Marietta, GA; daughter, Rhonda (James) Watson of Loganville, GA; daughter-in-law, Susan Van Horn of Walsenburg, CO; granddaughter, Dr. Yvette Brown of Marietta, GA; grandson, Lucas Brown of Covington, GA; and great-grandson, Everett Brown; nieces, nephews, sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law.

After leaving military life, he went into construction during the growth boom in Detroit, Michigan where he met his bride, Ruth. He moved to Roswell, GA in 1960, joining T&B Builders, completing training as a carpenter. Turning his love of farming into a hobby in Roswell, he raised apple trees, peach trees, pear trees, tomatoes, melons, game birds, bees, and lastly, blueberries.

Another hobby was photography, which he put to use taking Dean and Lillian's wedding photographs. He took flying lessons (in an airplane) as one of his last

hobbies.

He was a long-time member of Roswell First Baptist Church and Atlanta Street Baptist Church. He loved his Lord and looked forward to seeing Him face to face. He served as a Deacon at Atlanta Street Baptist Church.
