Dr. William Charles Montgomery, age 65, of Alpharetta, GA passed away on October 14, 2011. Dr. Montgomery graduated from the University of Minnesota with a Ph.D. in Chemistry and worked for over 40 years in the pharmaceutical industry with DuPont, Applera, Atherogenics and Salutria Pharmaceuticals. His passion was serving as a Deacon and Bible Study leader for over 30 years with Ogletown Baptist Church of Newark, DE and Crabapple First Baptist Church of Milton, GA.
