May 23, 1923 - May 15, 2013

William D. Crosby, Sr., age 89 of Roswell, GA, died on May 15th. Mr. Crosby was born in Hamilton, MS on May 23, 1923 and spent the first years of his life working, studying, and playing on the family farm. After high school, Mr. Crosby enrolled and graduated from Memphis State University. At the end of his college career, Mr. Crosby joined the United States Air Force. He was trained as an air navigator to support his country's WWII efforts. When WWII ended, he was discharged from the Air Force in Springfield, MA. While in Springfield, Mr. Crosby met and married his wife of 65 years, Frances Bessette Crosby. Mrs. Crosby passed away on September 20th, 2011. Mr. Crosby worked his entire career with Gilbarco Manufacturing in various assignments. His career took him to live in Springfield, MA, Atlanta, GA, Louisville, KY and Greensboro, NC. He and his wife Frances retired to Roswell, GA where they both spent the last years of their lives near family and friends at St. George Village. Mr. Crosby is survived by his daughter, Carole (Dave) Scofield of Norcross, GA, son Lee (Becky) Crosby of Valdosta, GA and four grandchildren, Megan (Brenton) Heffernan, Libby Scofield, Billy (Kym) Crosby, and Bond Crosby. A memorial Mass/service will be held at St. George Village, Roswell, GA on Tuesday, May 28 at 7pm in the auditorium.
