William Jennings Bryan Ball, Jr., 81 of Alpharetta, GA, passed from this life on May 18, 2008. Born in Rochelle, Georgia on July 15, 1926, he married Jean Thomas Ball on September 17, 1950 in Waycross after serving in the United States Naval Air Corp from 1944-1946. He retired in 1982 as senior vice president of the National Bank of Georgia after 31 years of service, continuing his service in the banking industry as senior vice president of First Union for ten years. Among his many accomplishments, he was president of the DeKalb County Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of the Better Business Bureau of Atlanta, twelve year member U.S. National Advisory Council of the U.S. Small Business Administration, chairman of the Georgia Motor Club, and served as an advisory board member of AAA.
