



Mr. William Joseph Newman

October 19, 1924 - May 5, 2017

William J. (Bill) Newman died May 5, 2017 at the age of 92; was married to Ann P. (Nancy) Loughlin for 66 years; father of Chris, Mary, Stephen, Bill, Richard, Vincent, Ann, Andrew and Jane. He is also survived by 27 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. Bill had two brothers, Bob of Upper St. Clair, PA and Jack of Garden City, Long Island and two sisters, Dr. Ann Smith of Jericho, NY and Mary Meehan who is deceased. Bill was born in Brooklyn, NY, grew up in Bellerose, Long Island. He attended Regis High School, Fordham University, New York University Graduate School of business, all in New York City. In World War II Bill served with the 95th Infantry Division. He was a Forward Observer in the 359th Field Artillery Bn which supported the 379th Infantry Reg. The 95th received 3 Battle Stars for major battles at Metz in eastern France, in the Siegfried Line at Saarlautern on Germany's western border, in the Battle of the Bulge in Luxembourg and across the Rhine River into the Battle of the Ruhr Pocket. In this last battle of the war in Europe the 95th Division was part of the 9th U.S. Army that took the surrender of the largest remaining German Army. In the Battle of the Ruhr Pocket at the town of Budberg, Germany in an encounter with German tanks Bill received the Bronze Star Medal for heroic achievement. After the war Bill finished college. With a B.A. and M.B.A. he then for 37 years worked in various positions in marketing and management until his retirement.
