November 15, 1964 - March 27, 2010

Pope - William Sewell and son Bryce Sewell were tragically killed in a car accident Saturday evening, March 27, 2010. Bill, 45, was born in Honolulu, Hawaii and raised in Thomaston, GA. He attended Robert E. Lee High School and graduated from Valdosta State University where he was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon. Bill worked for many years in the Pharmaceuticals Industry and most recently was the founder and Managing Partner of Pope Global Ventures. Bryce, 11, was born in Atlanta, Georgia. Bryce attended Alpharetta Methodist Christian Academy, and was currently in the fifth grade at Fellowship Christian School, where a scholarship fund has been set up in his name.

Bryce loved his sister Madison, Golf, playing Air Soft and Georgia Tech. Bill and Bryce are survived by wife and mother, Jane, daughter and sister, Madison.

Predeceasing Bill was his mother Charle' Pope. Bill is also survived by Father John I. Pope, Jr., Brothers John I Pope, III, Benjamin N Pope and Stephen C Pope, In-laws, Robert and Sharon Clements, Jr., Sister-in-law and Brother-in-law, Robert and Debbie Guinn, and numerous nieces, nephews and other relatives also survive.
